From the early Sixties, Sergio Lombardo joined the group of the “Scuola di Piazza del Popolo”, Rome - a movement which included artists such as Mario Schifano, Tano Festa, and Jannis Kounellis. He represented Italy at the VI Paris Biennale in 1969 and in the Venice Biennale of 1970. He has exhibited at the National Museum of Modern Art in Tokyo (1967), the Jewish Museum in New York (1968), the PS1 in New York (1999), the Tate Modern in London (2015), the Walker Art Center in Minneapolis (2015), the Dallas Museum of Art (2015), the Philadelphia Museum of Art (2016) and in other prestigious museums and collections around the world.
